

## ANNOUNCEMENT

The Rwanda TVET Board (RTB) is pleased to announce the continuation of the TVET Scholarship Programme, launched in 2023 in partnership with the German Government through KfW Development Bank. The programme will continue to provide scholarships to newly eligible students enrolled in Technical Secondary Schools across Rwanda.

Currently, the scholarship supports 2,787 students nationwide, with a target of expanding its coverage to 4,000 beneficiaries by the 2026/2027 academic year. This initiative reflects the shared commitment of RTB and its partners to increasing equitable access to quality Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) and strengthening the country's skilled workforce.

This project provides a comprehensive scholarship package to the best-performing students from low-income households who have successfully completed the Ordinary Level (O'Level) and are enrolled in Level 3 at selected Technical Secondary Schools (TSS) provided below. The scholarship is designed to support students pursuing technical education in the following programmes:

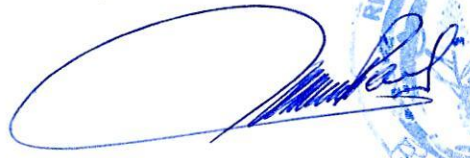
